AFTER BAPTISM, THE TESTING TIME.

As His Ministry was about to begin, Jesus came from His home town of Nazareth to the Jordan Valley where John, His cousin, was baptising. Entering the waters of the Jordan, Jesus rejected John's objections and insisted that He be baptised, as an example for those who would follow Him. And as the waters of baptism were poured the heavens were opened and the Spirit of God descended upon Him in the form of a dove and the voice came from heaven: "This is My beloved Son, in Whom I am well pleased."

Immediately after this awesome confirmation of Jesus as Messiah, the Gospels tell us that that same Spirit led Jesus out into the wilderness where, in His Sacred Humanity, He would have to face up to the choices required in order to obey the will of His Father, even if that meant the Cross of Calvary.

For us who have been baptised, the choices are the same: to obey the will of our Father or to give in to the temptations which come our way. This will not only be a matter of avoiding sin but, more beneficially, of choosing to do good, for example, attending Mass more frequently, praying the Rosary each day, visiting the sick and lonely, reading the Gospel of each day, finding ways to help the poor and outcasts.

Stations of the Cross will be held at 7.00pm each Friday during Lent, with a different leader each week.

The "step by step" series will restart on Wednesday of this week February 21st, following the 7.00pm Mass.

The Lenten Penitential Service will take place on Wednesday, March 21st at 7.00pm.

On Tuesday of Holy Week we shall celebrate a **Passover Supper** in the hall at 7.00pm.

The Easter Vigil will be at 8.00pm on Saturday March 31st.

Tuesday of this week is the anniversary of the date when Blessed Antonio Rosmini wrote the Rule of the Institute of Charity. We call this day the 'day of the Cell' and the Mass at 9.30am will be the Mass in honour of Blessed Antonio Rosmini.
