All Gift Aid offerings are topped up by 25% courtesy of the Tax Man <u>AT NO EXTRA COST TO YOU!</u> All you need to do is to sign a simple declaration form stating you are a taxpayer and we will do the rest – the forms are available at the back of the Church.

The numbers in the scheme are dropping, due to mainly older parishioners passing away.
